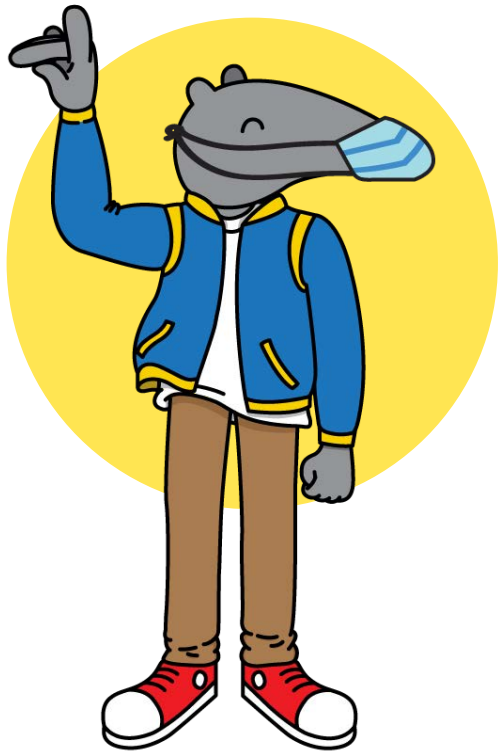

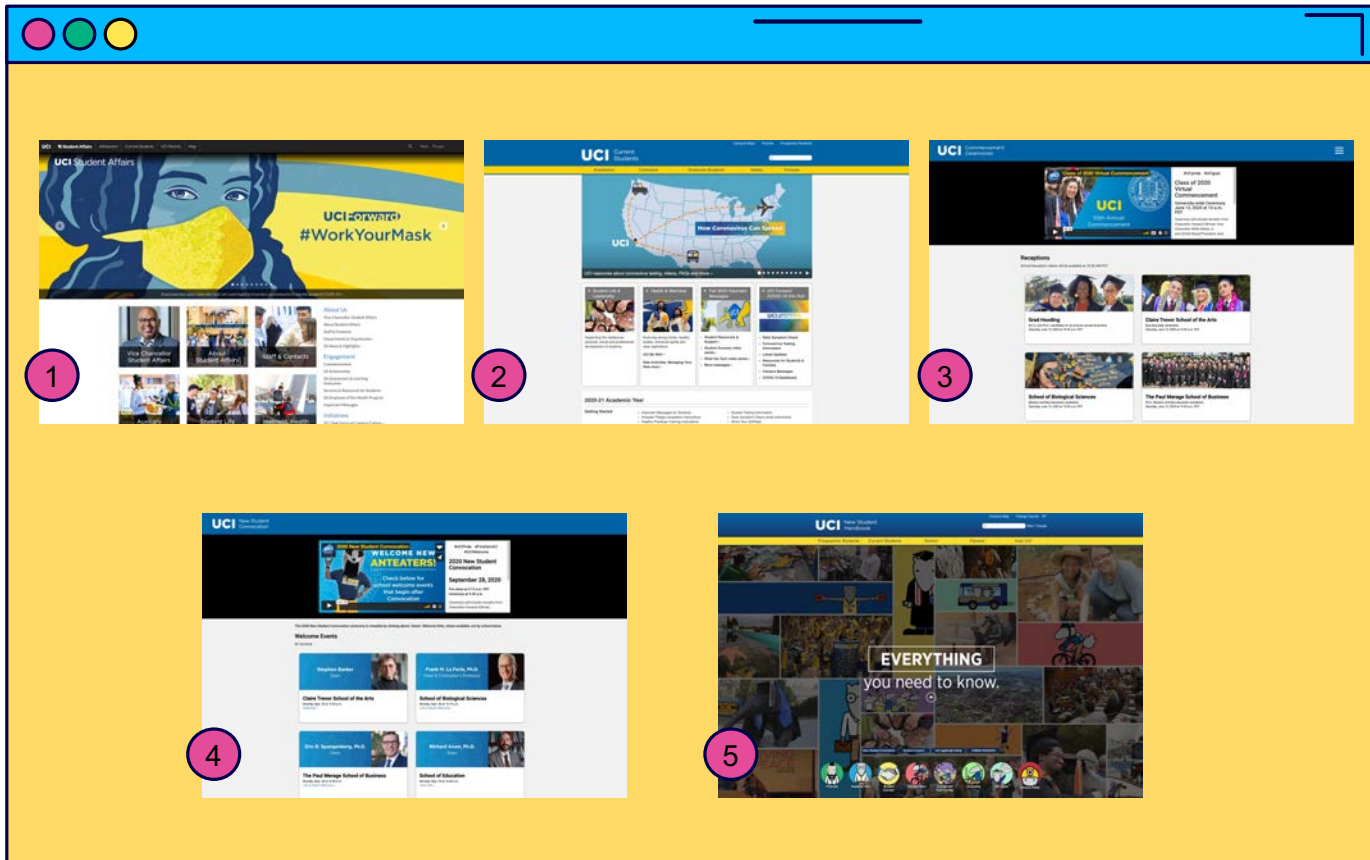

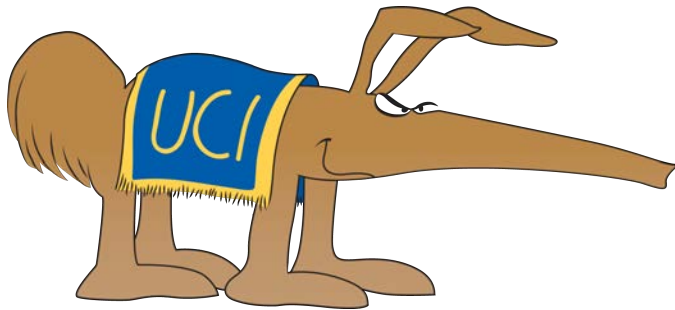

COVID-19 testing for all undergraduate on-campus residents begins today, October 5 and continues through October 9. Ongoing weekly testing for all student residents resumes on October 19 until further notice.

Here are answers to some common questions we have received:

Did we move the site locations from outdoors to indoors?

Collection sites were moved indoors due to concerns with inclement weather such as heat waves we are currently experiencing and the air quality caused by local fires. The sites will continue to have safety measures in place such as physical distancing markers, a touchless check-in process, plexiglass and physical barriers. Appointment time is set up to minimize any overcrowding or long queues so that an appointment is completed in less than 10 minutes. These plans have been approved by Orange County Public Health Agency.

Is there a private area at the testing center where the collection can be done?

Yes, there is a private area for students to conduct the nasal swab. Just let the staff know you would like to use the private area.

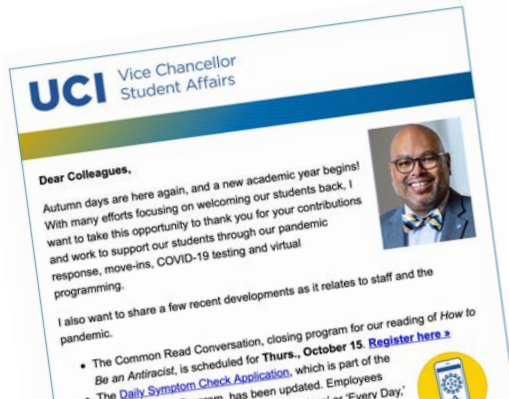

EMPLOYMENT & VOCATIONAL SERVICES

Help veterans with their careers by:

- Identifying a warrior's transferable skills.
- Connecting veterans to military-friendly employers.
- Helping a returning service member access veteran job training programs and opportunities.

WHY ASK THE QUESTIONS?

Most employers know if you have a veteran you will bring something someone with a strong work ethic and a lot of transferable skills. Those who provide employment and vocational services need to identify and engage job-seeking veterans clients and help them to highlight their strengths in ways that will appeal to civilian employers. The first step is identifying your veteran clients and how to connect them and their families to services.

At the point of intake, ASK THE QUESTIONS:

- Have you or a family member served in the military?
- Do you have any children?

When THE ANSWER IS YES, you may consider thinking them for their service. You may also want to find out more about their military experience in order to provide the best possible services and referrals. Also, you will be able to provide them with services for their children. Asking these questions will also help you to:

- Build rapport and demonstrate interest and cultural competency
- Link to any needed military and veteran resources and referrals, including VA and non-VA programs.
- Assist in translating and matching military service experience to civilian language and jobs.
- Identify any needs for social, cognitive, emotional, or physical accommodations.
- Explore any barriers to reintegration into the workforce.
- Address potential barriers to seeking support and services.
- Link to family services available to children of veterans.

Anteater Pledge

I understand that all students who come onto campus or other UCI-controlled property must abide by the university's precautionary measures. Should I choose not to abide by these requirements, I understand that I will be denied access to on-campus buildings and services when they are open. I also understand that failure to comply with these requirements may be a violation of the UCI Student Code of Conduct and may result in disciplinary measures. Faculty and staff are required to abide by similar requirements.

As a dedicated member of the Anteater community, and in recognition of the potential consequences of my choices, I have done or intend to do all of the following:

- Complete the UCI "Health Practices" online training by September 30, 2020, and contact your certificate of completion to CampusCares for students at campuscares@uci.edu.
- Stay in my residence if I am experiencing any of the symptoms listed in the UCI Living Well™ Daily Symptom Check application and do not enter UCI shared spaces (including classes or dining halls).
- Report any UCI-related COVID-19 infections to the UCI Coronavirus Response Center at 949-924-0998 or coronavirus@uci.edu.
- Wear a face covering when on UCI-controlled property or off campus and I am not able to maintain at least six feet of physical distance from another individual.
- Maintain physical distancing on UCI-controlled property.
- Agree to be tested for COVID-19 on the schedule determined by the university.
- Obtain a flu vaccination no later than November 1, 2020.
- Participate in contact tracing efforts by responding to outreach from contact tracers and taking other contact tracing actions when asked to do so.
- Immediately report any COVID-related safety concerns to safety@uci.edu or 949-924-0998.
- Consistently practice all COVID-19 precautions when off campus (e.g., maintaining a physical distance of at least six feet from those I do not live with, wearing a face covering as appropriate when I am outside of my residence, and practicing frequent and thorough hand washing).
- Comply with all other UCI directives that may be issued, and which may change from time to time, regarding precautions to take when the rate of transmission of COVID-19.

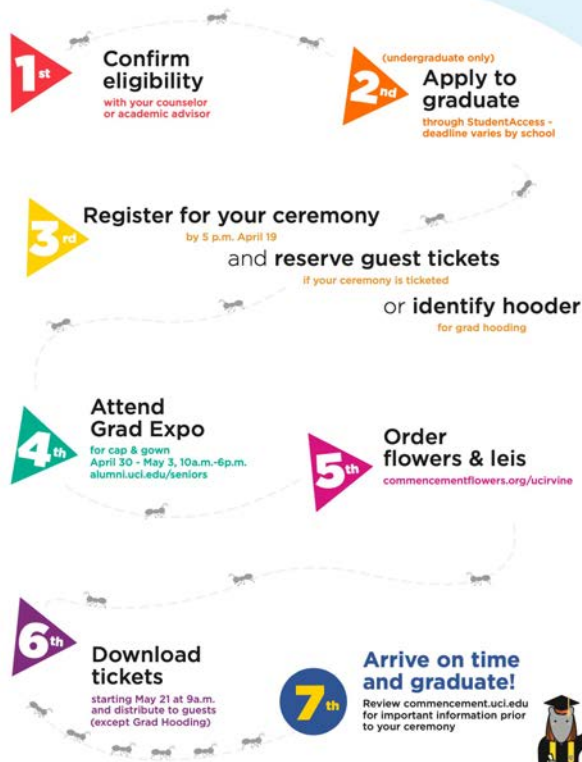

UCI Commencement

Faculty/Staff Complainant Support Services (FSCSS) provides support from the initial point of contact through resolution of the incident by the University, serving as a liaison to coordinate support with various campus offices who may be involved directly or indirectly with the investigation and adjudication process.

FSCSS can provide support for interim accommodations, as well as work to connect faculty and staff to appropriate on- or off-campus referrals such as CARE, the Employee Assistance Program (EAP), Human Resources, the Office of Equal Opportunity & Diversity (OEOD), and Academic Departments. FSCSS will work directly with the Vice Provost and Academic Personnel office as needed.

Please Note: Survivors of sexual assault & domestic violence have a right to have a confidential CARE Advocate accompany them for any services at the hospital and at subsequent law enforcement or administrative interviews. Advocates are also able to assist with accommodations, financial needs and healing programs. Advocacy services are available to faculty/staff through the CARE office.

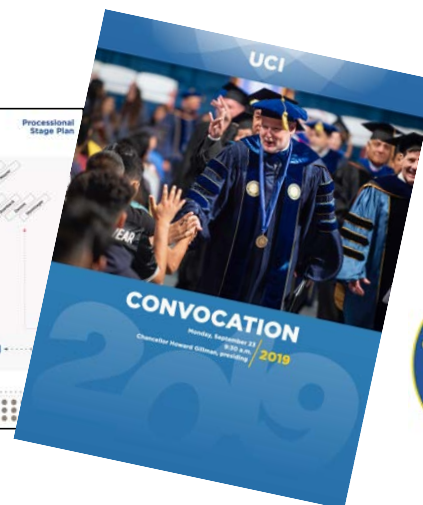

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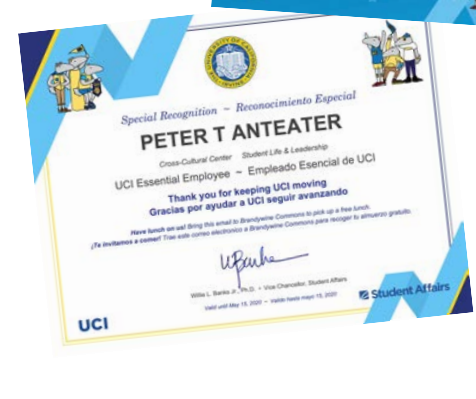

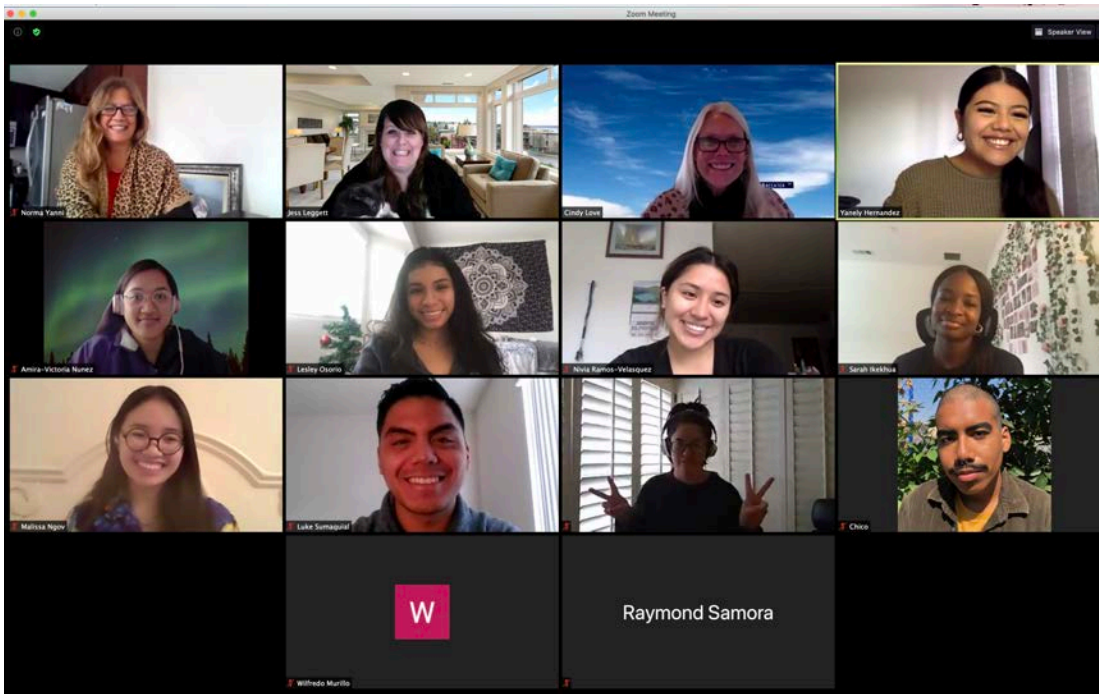
